WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider applications relating to zoning;

WHEREAS, the notice and public hearing requirements pursuant to Article 2 (Application Processes and Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, Ordinance 2003-067 as amended (ULDC), have been satisfied;

WHEREAS, Zoning Application CA-2018-00740 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners at a public hearing conducted on November 26, 2018;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the Applicant and other interested parties, the recommendations of the various County Review Agencies, and the recommendation of the Zoning Commission;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Article 2 (Application Processes and Procedures) of the ULDC is authorized and empowered to consider, approve, approve with conditions or deny the request;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners hereby incorporates by reference the Findings in the staff report addressing the Standards contained in Article 2.B (Public Hearing Processes) for a Class A Conditional Use;

WHEREAS, this approval is subject to Article 2.E (Monitoring), of the ULDC and other provisions requiring that development commence in a timely manner;

WHEREAS, the issuance of this Development Permit does not in any way create any rights on the part of the Applicant and/or Property Owner to obtain a permit from a state or federal agency and does not create any liability on the part of the County for issuance of the permit if the Applicant fails to obtain requisite approvals or fulfill the obligations imposed by a state or federal agency or undertakes actions that result in a violation of state or federal law:

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Survey Section may administratively correct any scrivener's errors that will not significantly impact the overall boundary of the adopted legal description; and,

WHEREAS, Article 2.B.6.C (Board Action) of the ULDC requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Zoning Application CA-2018-00740, the Application of All Star Kids Early Learning Center 2 LLC, by Miller Land Planning, Agent, for a Class A Conditional Use to allow a Day Care General, on a parcel of land generally described as shown on the legal description in EXHIBIT A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and generally located as shown on a vicinity sketch as indicated in EXHIBIT B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, was approved on November 26, 2018, subject to the Conditions of Approval described in EXHIBIT C, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

COMMENCING AT THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 42 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, PROCEED SOUTHWESTERLY ALONG A CURVE CONCAVE TO THE NORTHWEST HAVING A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 77° 46' 34" AND RADIUS OF 2420.23 FEET, SAID CURVE BEING THE CENTERLINE OF 120 FEET DEDICATED EASEMENT TO A POINT LYING 252.9 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 36, AS MEASURED PARALLEL TO THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 36, SAID POINT BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING; FROM THE POINT OF BEGINNING SOUTHWESTERLY ALONG THE AFOREDESCRIBED CURVE TO A POINT LYING 495.8 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 36, AS MEASURED PARALLEL TO THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 36; THENCE PROCEED WESTERLY PARALLEL TO THE NORTH SECTION LINE, AS MEASURED PARALLEL TO THE NORTH SECTION LINE, AS MEASURED PARALLEL TO THE NORTH SECTION LINE; THENCE PROCEED NORTHERLY PARALLEL TO THE WEST SECTION LINE A DISTANCE OF 242.9 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE PROCEED EASTERLY TO A POINT NORTH SECTION LINE TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

VICINITY SKETCH



CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

Conditional Use Class A

ALL PETITIONS

1. The approved Preliminary Site Plan is dated August 27, 2018. Modifications to the Development Order inconsistent with the Conditions of Approval, or changes to the uses or site design beyond the authority of the Development Review Officer as established in the Unified Land Development Code, must be approved by the Board of County Commissioners or the Zoning Commission. (ONGOING: ZONING - Zoning)

ENGINEERING

- 1. In order to comply with the mandatory Traffic Performance Standards, the Property Owner shall be restricted to the following phasing schedule:
- a. No Building Permits for the site may be issued after December 31, 2020. A time extension for this condition may be approved by the County Engineer based upon an approved Traffic Study which complies with Mandatory Traffic Performance Standards in place at the time of the request. This extension request shall be made pursuant to the requirements of Art. 2.E of the Unified Land Development Code. (DATE: MONITORING Engineering)
- 2. The Property Owner shall provide an acceptable drainage study identifying any historical drainage from offsite parcels, including proposed grading cross sections. The project's stormwater management system shall be designed to address any historical drainage. The Property Owner shall provide drainage easements, as required, to accommodate offsite drainage.
- a. Drainage study shall be provided the Land Development Division prior to final approval of the Site Plan by the DRO. (DRO: ENGINEERING Engineering)
- b. Any required drainage easements shall be recorded prior to issuance of the first building permit. (BLDGPMT: MONITORING Engineering)
- 3. Prior to issuance of the first Building Permit, the Property Owner shall record a line of sight easement as shown on the accompanying site plan. Line of sight easement shall be approved by the County Attorney and the County Engineer prior to recordation. (BLDGPMT: MONITORING Engineering)
- 4. The Property Owner shall design, install, and perpetually maintain median landscape within the median of all abutting right of way of Seminole Pratt Whitney Road. This landscaping and irrigation shall strictly conform to the specifications and standards for the County's Only Trees, Irrigation, and Sod (OTIS) program. Additional landscaping beyond OTIS requires Board of County Commissioner's approval. Median landscaping installed by the Property Owner shall be perpetually maintained by the Property Owner, his successors and assigns, without recourse to Palm Beach County, unless the Property Owner provides payment for maintenance as set forth in Paragraph c and d below.
- a. The necessary permit(s) for this landscaping and irrigation shall be applied for from Palm Beach County Land Development prior to the issuance of the first building permit. (BLDGPMT: MONITORING Engineering)
- b. All installation of the landscaping and irrigation shall be completed prior to the issuance of the first certificate of occupancy. (BLDGPMT/CO: MONITORING Engineering)
- c. At Property Owner's option, when and if the County is ready to install OTIS on the surrounding medians of this roadway adjacent to the Property Owner installed landscaping, payment for the maintenance may be provided to the County. The payment shall be in the amount and manner that complies with the schedule for such payments that exists on the date payment is made. Once payment has been provided, Palm Beach County shall assume the maintenance responsibility for the OTIS landscaping and irrigation that has been installed by the Property Owner. The Property Owner shall first be required to correct any deficiencies in the landscaping and irrigation. This option is not available to medians with additional landscaping beyond OTIS standards, unless those medians are first brought into conformance with OTIS standards by the Property Owner. (ONGOING: MONITORING

- d. Alternately, at the option of the Property Owner or if the construction of the required landscape and irrigation is not possible due to physical constraints, the Property Owner may make a contribution to the County's Only Trees Irrigation and Sod, (OTIS) program, unincorporated thoroughfare beautification program prior to the issuance of the first Building Permit. This payment option is only available if the roadway segment is included in the County's current OTIS Master Plan and shall be based on the project's front footage along Seminole Pratt Whitney Road. This payment shall be in the amount and manner that complies with the schedule for such payments as it currently exists or as it may from time to time be amended. (BLDGPMT: MONITORING Engineering)
- 5. The Property Owner shall fund the cost of the right turn lane, if warranted, on the north approach on Seminole Pratt Whitney Road at the project entrance road. The cost shall include all design, permitting and construction costs as well as any required utility relocation and right of way or easement acquisition that may be needed.
- a. Building Permits shall not be issued until the Property Owner provides acceptable surety to the Traffic Division in an amount as determined by the County Engineer. (BLDGPMT: MONITORING Engineering)
- b. In order to request release of the surety for the right turn lane at the above location, the Property Owner shall provide written notice to the Traffic Division stating that the final certificate of occupancy has been issued for this development and requesting that a traffic study be conducted at intersection of Seminole Pratt Whitney Rd and the project entrance road to determine if a right turn lane is warranted. The Traffic Division shall have 24 months from receipt of this notice to either draw upon the monies to construct the turn lane or release the monies. In the event that the property is sold, the surety may be returned once the Traffic Division receives written documentation of the sale and a replacement surety has been provided to the Traffic Division by the new Property Owner. (BLDGPMT/CO: MONITORING Engineering)

LANDSCAPE - GENERAL

1. Prior to Final Approval by the Development Review Officer (DRO), the Property Owner shall finalize the Preliminary Vegetation Disposition Chart to ensure all Vegetation that is subject to either preservation; relocation on site; replacement or mitigation shall be clearly identified on the Site Plan. The Chart and what is shown on the Plan shall be consistent. (DRO: ZONING - Zoning)

SITE DESIGN

1. Prior to Final Approval by the Development Review Officer (DRO), the Property Owner shall amend the Site Plan to provide a minimum 8-foot wide porch (covered walkway) around the entire Day Care building. (DRO: ZONING - Zoning)

COMPLIANCE

- 1. In Granting this Approval, the Board of County Commissioners relied upon the oral and written representations of the Property Owner/Applicant both on the record and as part of the application process. Deviations from or violation of these representations shall cause the Approval to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for review under the Compliance Condition of this Approval. (ONGOING: MONITORING Zoning)
- 2. Failure to comply with any of the Conditions of Approval for the subject property at any time may result in:
- a. The Issuance of a Stop Work Order; the Issuance of a Cease and Desist Order; the Denial or Revocation of a Building Permit; the Denial or Revocation of a Certificate of Occupancy; the Denial of any other Permit, License or Approval to any developer, Owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; the Revocation of any other permit, license or approval from any developer, Owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; the Revocation of any concurrency; and/or
- b. The Revocation of the Official Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or any other zoning approval; and/or
- c. A requirement of the development to conform with the standards of the Unified Land Development Code at the time of the finding of non-compliance, or the addition or modification of conditions reasonably related to the failure to comply with existing

Conditions of Approval; and/or

- d. Referral to Code Enforcement; and/or
- e. Imposition of entitlement density or intensity.

Staff may be directed by the Executive Director of PZ&B or the Code Enforcement Special Master to schedule a Status Report before the body which approved the Official Zoning Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or other zoning approval, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.E of the ULDC, in response to any flagrant violation and/or continued violation of any Condition of Approval. (ONGOING: MONITORING - Zoning)

DISCLOSURE

1. All applicable state or federal permits shall be obtained before commencement of the development authorized by this Development Permit.
