RESPONSE TO CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS:

1. GC 53 describes the one year correction period which starts after final acceptance. GC 55 describes partial utilization and also notes that the correction period doesn't start until final completion. For this project, it is conceivable that we will not reach final acceptance until 2+ YEARS after the first well is completed and put online. The GC's as written in essence require us to correct work that that well for 3+ years after the date at which we would receive partial utilization (assume 2 years from partial utilization of the first completed well to date of final acceptance and 1 year for the correction period for a total of 3 years). Can the correction period condition be adjusted to take this into account?

a. ***The warranty period shall be 1-year from the date of Final Completion as stated in the Contract Documents and the Form of Guarantee.***

2. Also, the docs require builder's risk insurance, but I don't think that should apply since we aren't performing any vertical construction. Can you please clarify/confirm?

a. ***Please reference General Conditions pages GC-16 & 17. The Insurance Coverage & Limit Table shows that Builders Risk coverage is not required for this contract and Inland Marine/Transit Coverage is required.***
