The following notes are a summary of the information provide at the discussions of the WRTF. This summary is not a transcript of the meeting.

Mayor Greg Weiss was nominated for Chairman of the Water Resources Task Force by Rachelle Litt that was seconded by Tommy Strowd. A vote was taken and Greg Weiss was elected unanimously to be the new Chairman of the Water Resources Task Force.

Paul Linton, P.E. Palm Beach County Water Resources Manager provided and update on the FEMA FIRM appeal. FEMA has approved an Independent Scientific Panel Review of the appeal. Subsequent to the meeting the five panel members were selected and met on October 6, 2023. The next step is a presentation to the Scientific Panel by FEMA and PBC which is schedule for November 20, 2023.

Paul Linton, P.E. Palm Beach County Water Resources Manager provide an "Overview of Onsite Sewage Treatment and Disposal Systems (Septic Tanks) in Palm Beach County" the presentation was difficult to follow due to the size of the maps.

At the end of the meeting Chip Block resigned from the WRTF.
