The Education and Training Center is a community resource for primary prevention through education, training, and professional development. It provides free services to parents, children, families, school personnel, and mental health professionals in Palm Beach County. Family, individual, and group therapy services are offered, in addition to psychological evaluations. The Education and Training Center is responsible for developing and implementing trainings, workshops, and community outreach activities. It also serves as a student/trainee placement site for doctoral interns, postdoctoral fellows, and doctoral practicum trainees.
