

## 2022 Palm Beach County Super *virtual* Summer Camp Spelling Bee

---

### RULES

1. All spellers must be enrolled in a school within Palm Beach County and attend a camp participating in the PBC 2022 Summer Camp Scholarship Program.
2. Spellers will consist of incoming K – 12 students.
3. YSD staff and partners will make appropriate ADA accommodations to meet the special needs of competitors.
4. Parent(s), camp counselor(s) and guardians are not allowed to assist the students during the competition. Failure to comply may result in contestant's disqualification.
5. Camp counselors are expected to supervise their campers at all times.

#### Registration

Registration must be completed in the SCSP portal no later than July 12, 2022: <https://www.pbcgov.org/summercamp/Account/Login>

1. Providers will enter speller information through the Spelling Bee tab under the type: *Participant*.
2. Providers must register their top 3 contestants for each grade level in the SCSP portal no later than July 12, 2022.
  - a. There is no registration on the day of the bee.
  - b. Any camper who participates in the bee that is not registered in the SCSP portal is subject to disqualification.
  - c. Camps may not substitute spellers on the day of the bee. Any changes must be made in the SCSP portal before the deadline of July 12, 2022.
  - d. Spellers will register for the category that includes the grade they will be entering in the upcoming fall school year.
    - i. Categories consist of competitors entering grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12.
3. Each speller must have a completed "Palm Beach County, Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability" form uploaded into the SCSP portal.

#### Contest

1. Spellers will join the Spelling Bee virtually utilizing the Zoom link provided after registration closes on July 12, 2022.
2. The words will be provided during the bee using the Kahoot! platform.
  - a. Spellers will need access to a device that allows utilization of this website.
3. Judges will read the word aloud to all spellers.
4. The contestant must select the correct spelling of that word from the four (4) words provided.
5. Kahoot! scores the contestants on accuracy and speed.
6. Each category will produce three (3) champions (*categories: K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade, 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade*).
