

Network Analysis

The Girls Coordinating Council (GCC) conducted a network analysis to better understand the network of mental health and juvenile justice service providers for girls in Palm Beach County. The study found that there is generally good connectivity and centrality in the network, with opportunities to strengthen collaborations between some key organizations on the periphery of the network. The network map, showing which organizations work with one another to provide services, is depicted below. The GCC is implementing efforts to increase collaboration among organizations and will repeat the study in August. In addition to repeating the study in August, the GCC is planning a new study to examine administrative burdens families face when trying to access juvenile justice and mental health services for girls. The GCC will continue to share the findings of the network analysis.
