

## PUBLIC NOTICE Palm Beach County

Palm Beach County Department of Economic Sustainability (DES) proposes to amend its Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2010-2011 as follows:

## Proposed 20<sup>th</sup> Amendment to FY 2010-2011 Action Plan

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Neighborhood Stabilization Program-3 made available funds of \$11,264,172 to Palm Beach County.

The proposed 20<sup>th</sup> Amendment will revise the budget for the Palm Beach County Housing Authority's South Bay Villas project by decreasing by \$718,090.50 the funding set aside for households earning no more than 50% of Area Median Income (AMI), and increasing by \$718,090.50 the funding set aside for households earning between 51% and 120% of AMI. Total funding will remain the same.

This amendment will also revise the budget for Pahokee Housing Authority and HTG McClure LLC's McClure Village project by decreasing by \$1,508,021.50 the funding set aside for households earning no more than 50% of AMI, and increasing by \$1,508,021.50 the funding set aside for households earning between 51% and 120% AMI. Total funding will remain the same.
