

## Trees in a Natural Environment


- Trees grow in groups
- Trees compete with each other for sunlight
- Trees develop single, central trunks





## Trees in a Urban Environment

- Trees planted singularly
- No competition for sunlight
- Trees develop multiple, codominant trunks



# What to Look For in a Tree

- Single, straight trunk
- Good branch attachment
- Evenly spaced branches
