Financially Assisted Agencies (FAA) Notice of Funding Opportunities (NOFO) FY21 Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Please explain, the statement, "with a special emphasis on families that are 100% below FPL"? Please provide an example.
 - This means that you would propose a focus on recruiting those at 100% below FPL to your program or prioritizing them in some way so that you are emphasizing services to this group.
- 2. Is the grant recipient required to assist 188 households or is this a County-wide goal where when all grant recipients' outcomes are combined, 188 households will have been assisted? On Page 9 it was stated, "the goals for this initiative are to: 1. Assist <u>188 households annually</u> with services that will increase their household income above 100 percent of FPL and to maintain or improve this income level for a minimum of two years.
 - This is a county wide goal. You should set your goal based on your program capacity and budget request.
- 3. Can organizations that have existing contracts apply for additional funding to support clients through this NOFO?
 - Yes, you can apply to this NOFO even if you already have an existing FAA contract.
 - If you are applying to this NOFO for the program that is already funded through FAA, you would need to serve more clients and use the funds to expand the program.

- 4. Can we submit essentially the same application, only updated to reflect activity to today?
 - You would need to review the NOFO guidance and respond to the questions accordingly including describing your project and how it would meet the requirements of the current NOFO.
