## **STRATEGY FOR ALIGNMENT**

- ALIGNMENT FOR HOUSING/HOMELESSNESS HAS ALREADY OCCURRED
- 2. SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE AGENCY WILL BE MATCHED TO RESPECTIVE BCC PRIORITY AREA
- 3. ONE OR TWO YEAR CONTRACTS WILL BE RECOMMENDED TO FACILITATE ALIGNEMENT
- 4. SPECIAL CONSIDERATION WILL BE GIVEN TO AGENCIES THAT ARE ALREADY FUNDED TO PREVENT THE CREATION OF SERVICES GAPS WITHIN THE HHS SYSTEM OF CARE

- Economic Development- To promote economic revitalization by driving the creation of employment opportunities while reducing disparities and improving quality of life for everyone.

The idea is to use a systems thinking approach, not removing a substantial amount of funding in any particular category. Subpopulations would continue to have priority focus. This would prevent us from creating a gap in the system. New funding from the proposed 3% increase would be used to address gaps identified in the Poverty, Behavioral Health and Homelessness needs assessment.
