Major Kneisley reported that the total population today of the jail is 2,877 which he noted represents a downward trend.



## B. Jail Counselor Report

The Jail Counselor, Mr. Fondiller, provided a report that showed the status of DCF transfers, misdemeanor booking averages, and a table of the January misdemeanor bookings. Mr. Fondiller reported that the total average of days misdemeanants spent in jail in January was 4.85 days. The average number of days for misdemeanants between booking and sentencing was 5.9 and the mean average was approximately 53.5 days for the month of January. This number does not include the 70% of persons that come in and out within the first day.

Members discussed the increase in the average number of days for misdemeanors and noted that they seemed much higher than anticipated. Mr. Fondiller stated that he would check the data for this report. Mr. Rodriguez also asked that the CJC Research and Planning Manager compile a comparative report to the Jail Counselor's report.

# C. Juvenile Detention Report

Department of Juvenile Justice Superintendent, Anthony Flowers supplied a report that showed the average population of the juvenile detention center in January was down to 69 which was the lowest population in the month of January in the past five years. (A copy of the full report is attached to the end of the minutes). He added that the Palm Beach County Detention center has five vacancies and noted that the department is currently under a hiring freeze.

# D. Pretrial Services Report

The Pretrial Service Manager, Mr. Trotta, provided members with a printed report detailing the Supervised Release Pretrial Services Program. The report notes that it is current as of February 2<sup>nd</sup>. He stated that there are a total of 1,445 defendants on Supervised Own Recognizance (S.O.R.) and that 1,113 of these are out of custody and are not occupying jail space. He further reported that there are a total of 641 defendants on S.O.R. only and 804 that have a money bond attached to the S.O.R. Members asked for the breakdown of the cases of individuals that are on S.O.R. and are awaiting placement to treatment. There were 8 cases listed on the current report.

#### VI. Old Business

# A. Potential Legislation affecting county jail population

The Task Force members discussed an analysis from the Sheriff's office regarding the potential budget cut that would transfer commitments at the Jimmy Ryce facility in Florida to county jails. Major Kneisley reported that this transfer would require specific jail space and estimated an annual operating cost of \$4 million in addition to an initial start-up capital cost of \$4 million for a 24-bed facility for these long term civil commitments. Ms. Spangengberg reported that there are 13 persons at the Jimmy Ryce facility that are from Palm Beach County. Major Kneisley reported that there has not been any new notices regarding the possible legislation that would change the structure of county jail sentence time frames beyond one year. The Task Force is continuing to monitor any legislation in reference to these issues.

#### B. Alternatives to Incarceration

Chairman Duncan reported that the Alternatives to Incarceration Advisory Board met on January 28, 2009 to review a program for day reporting requirements paper and to discuss the approach for such a day reporting center. The Board voted to remove the pretrial population from the requirements and decided to focus on the sentenced offender population. The Board directed CJC staff to develop a proposal for a day reporting center program to present to possible implementing agencies.

### VII. Additional Member and guest comments

Mr. Bozzone asked if the task force could research the issue of the inmate placements to treatment. Mr. Taylor mentioned that a planning committee has been working on a judges educational segment regarding ordering assessments. Mr. Fondiller noted that sometimes an inmate does not receive a Substance Abuse Awareness program (SAAP) assessment but a placement directly to one of the centers such as the Gratitude House. Members discussed the process of placing individuals into treatment. Commissioner Vana and Mr. Taylor discussed a procedure that would be automatic in getting an individual his/her assessment then direct placement. Judge Perez stated that an option would be for the Chief Judge to recommend the judges follow a drafted procedure for this. Chairman Duncan asked that staff invite Mr. Gillert from SAAP to the next monthly meeting to assist the task force in mapping out what the current process is for assessment and treatment placement.
