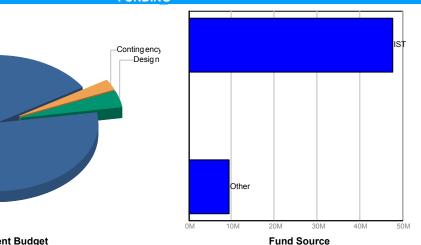

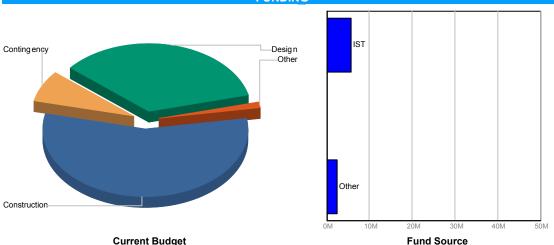

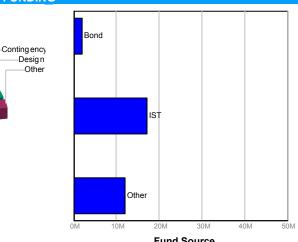

CM reviewing a change in the coolers and is pricing the recommendations with the MEP subcontractor. Addressing issues with the HVAC upgrade in Processing Garage to bring in more cooling capacity to help bring the room back to cooler conditions when a vehicle is brought in for processing. In certain areas of the building there is a lot of condensation forming on grills and insulation. This is being addressed with the design team. Toxicology has introduced some new equipment which is taxing the cooling system. The design team is looking at a way to rebalance the system or introduce added cooling capacity into the area. Final issues with landscaping permit closeout in preparation for Certificate of Occupancy are being addressed with the CM.
