The permit submission to the City of West Palm beach Building dept. will be coordinated with a Meeting with the AHJ and fire Marshal to review the plans, the fire alarm system replacement approach, and the Operational life safety equivalency letter, the meeting with the City is to be determined.

Total IST and Ad Valorem funding for this project is \$16,449,545; IST funds are \$12,999,700 "FY17 IST funds of \$1,300,000 and FY18 IST funds of \$8,699,700 are currently available", Ad Valorem funds are \$3,449,845

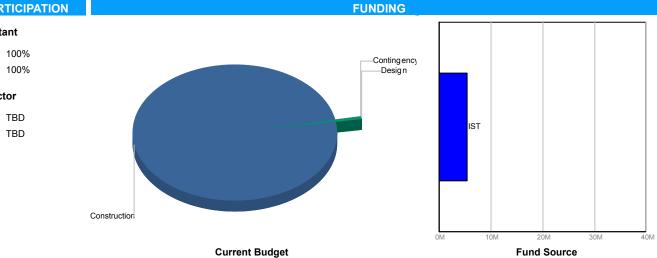

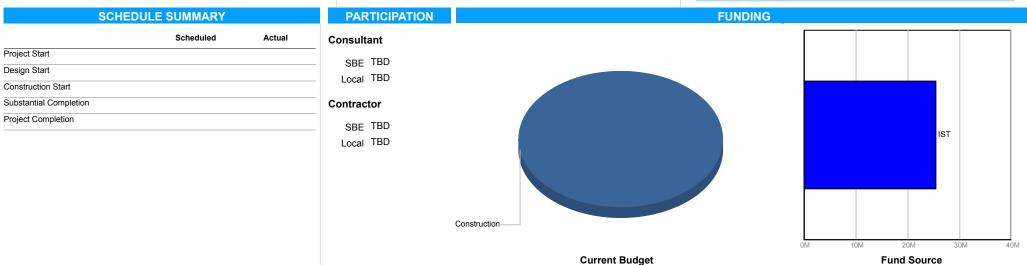

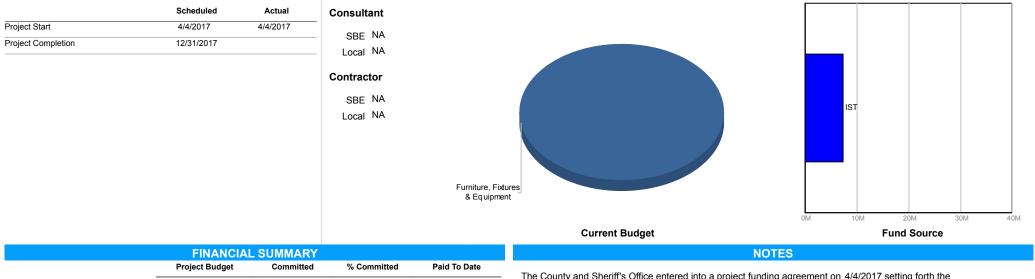
