Playground Renovation and Replacement



- \$398,750 originally allocated FY17, \$812,000 allocated FY18 and \$421,500 allocated FY19 for IST playground renovation and replacement.
- Estimates were based on 2014 cost to replace equipment.
- Inflation not factored into estimates.
- Additional funding is needed to adequately cover current replacement costs (increased materials and labor costs, inability to provide like-for-like product), and to account for changing trends in outdoor play.
