INDEPENDENT OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Palm Beach County Ordinance 2016-032 authorizes a countywide referendum for a local government infrastructure surtax of one percent (1%) on all authorized taxable transactions occurring within Palm Beach County. It also requires the creation of an independent citizen oversight committee ("Committee").

The Board of County Commissioners has adopted a Surtax Plan for use of the infrastructure surtax proceeds.

The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the establishment of a Committee for the purpose of overseeing the Surtax Plan.

Responsibilities & Mission

- 1. The Committee will meet monthly, or as needed, to oversee the Surtax Plan.
- 2. The Committee will issue an annual report.
- 3. The Committee will provide oversight and review expenditure reports produced by the County to:
 - a. Ensure that one hundred percent (100%) of proceeds are expended only for the purposes set forth in the ballot measure; and
 - b. Review expenditures are in compliance with the County's Surtax Plan; and
 - c. Make reports to the Board and County Administrator, which shall include, but not be limited to a statement indicating whether the County is in compliance with the requirements of the ballot measure and a summary of the Committee's proceedings and activities.
- 4. Membership Composition shall consist of thirteen (13) members who are residents of Palm Beach County, including:
 - a. One (1) representative appointed by the Palm Beach County League of Cities;
 - b. One (1) representative from the Black community as designated by the Urban League of Palm Beach County;
 - c. One (1) representative from the Hispanic Community as designated by the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce;
 - d. Two (2) representatives designated by the Business Forum of Palm Beach County as created under the economic council;
 - e. One (1) representative from the Glades as recommended by the Glades Area NAACP;
 - f. One (1) representative from the senior community as designated by the Coalition of Boynton West Residential Associations;
 - g. One (1) representative from the condominium residents as designated by the West Boca Community Council;
 - h. One (1) representative designated by the West Palm Beach Branch of the NAACP;
 - i. One (1) representative designated by the Education Commission; and

j.	One (1) representative designated from each of the following advisory committees: Audit, Finance, and Budget.
