Since the last submission, the Fleet category, including equipment, has increased because Fire Rescue has increased its Fleet from 303 to 322 vehicles. The Facilities category has increased with the addition of two new stations (Stations 44 and 48), a new Support Services facility, a new Administrative/Training facility and an increase in the facility cost per station.

Attached is a schedule with updated call-load data and our calculation of the impact fee based on this information.
