SUBJECT: BIRDS, HOBBY BREEDE

AUTHORITY: The Animal Care and Control Ord pance (Ord. 98-2) does not recognize

private raising soirds as a hobby which may occasionally result in

breeding.

POLICY: The raising of birds as a hubby snall be allowed as a use by right in all

agricultural zoning districts, and the AR/USA district, subject to the

following:

1. The holdy breeder shall not engage in the sale of more than 20 birds to the rublic during any consecutive twelve (12) month period. (Note: The ACC ordinance limits dog/cat hobby breeders to the same.)

2. The hooby breeder shall not harbor more than 40 birds on a parcel of land at any time. (Note: The ACC ordinance limits a SFR to a max 10-dogs/cats.)

3. The minimum's 2 for a parcel of land shall be 2 acres.

4. Shelters cages, and accessory structure shall be setback a minimum of 50 feet from all property lines.

5. Ottdoor shelters and cages shall be contained to specific areas on the ste and screened from view on all sides by a minimum six (6) foot high opaque fence or wall. The fence or wall shall be located within 20 feet of the containment area.

6. The hobby breeder shall locate birds which excessively screech, chirp, crow, or make loud noises away from residential properties as far as possible. Birds considered a nuisance by the Sheriff's Office shall be removed from the site.

7. Care, licensing, registration, and inspections shall be as required by the Animal Care and Control Ordinance (Ord. 98-2) and other applicable statutes.
